5 • Following-Distance & Headlight Rules

DIM HIGH BEAMS WITHIN (FT) — ONCOMING	500
DIM HIGH BEAMS WITHIN (FT) — FOLLOWING	200

6 • Seatbelt & Child Seat Laws

SEATS REQUIRED TO BELT	front seats plus all children under 16 in any seat
CHILD SEAT — AGE THRESHOLD	8
